

BURLINGTON INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT SPECIAL AIRPORT IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS APPROVED

Burlington International Airport will be undertaking a major step forward in completing its multi-phased south end development (SED) program this year as it had received funding for two key projects which are part of that important program. ARRA (American Recovery and Reinvestment Act) funding has been approved for reconstruction the intersection of taxiway “C” and “G” and to extend taxiway “G” south where it will intersect new taxiway “J” and will serve a new general aviation apron now nearing completion. This ARRA funded project is shown in ORANGE on the sketch below and received an ARRA grant of \$2,602,000.

The second project is for construction of taxiway “J” and additional work on the taxiway “G” extension to the south and has received an Airport Improvement Program (AIP) grant of \$2,401,600. This AIP funded project is shown in BLUE on the sketch below.

The total Federal funding involved in these two south end development projects is \$5,003,600.
