

**SUBJECT: SIDA Badge Renewal**

SIDA badges are valid until the last day of the month and year listed in the expiration date. For example if your expiration date says 01/10 then your badge is valid until January 31, 2010.

In order to renew your SIDA badge you will need the following:

- 1) A check for \$15.00 payable to the Burlington International Airport.
- 2) **For EVERY renewal, You must show TSA approved acceptable ID.**

For U.S. citizens there are only four types of acceptable IDs:

1. A passport only is acceptable
2. A valid drivers license **AND** a social security card,
3. A valid drivers license **AND** an original or certified copy of a birth certificate.

For Non-U.S. citizens, you must have the appropriate documentation with an A number.

Airport Operations is required to make copies of these IDs for your file.

- 3) If you have a driving endorsement on your badge (a white airplane on a blue or red background) you must take the applicable recurrent driver training test. You can contact Airport Operations for a copy of the test material or you can take the test when you come to get your badge renewed.
