Sealed Bids for **Construct Remain Overnight Apron, Phase 7** at the Burlington International Airport will be received by the owner at the 1200 Airport Drive #1, South Burlington, Vermont 05403 until 1:30 PM, April 17, 2020 local time and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

The work generally consists of the construction of a new remain overnight aircraft parking apron on the south side of the terminal apron. The work includes removal of existing asphalt pavements, construction of new PCC pavement and new full depth P-401 pavement, mill and overlay of P-401 pavement, new and temporary pavement markings, new drainage system including the construction of underground treatment and storage chambers new drainage pipe, new drainage structures.

Approximately 14,100 SY of new PCC pavement and 5300 SY of HMA pavement and a 1100 SY underground stormwater water quality and detention system.

Prospective bidders are asked to provide information on whether their company is listed as a Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) in the state where the work will be performed in order to comply with FAA regulations. Prospective bidders will be asked to provide this information at time of plan purchase.

All bidders shall provide the company email address for any Addenda that may be issued to clarify, correct or change the Bid Documents.

A pre-bid conference will be held at 10:00 AM, April 7, 2020 at Burlington International Airport, South Burlington, Vermont. This will be the only time for prospective Bidders or subcontractors to view the site. Bidders must advise the Airport Director's Office, (802) 863-2874 prior to April 6, 2020 if they are planning to attend.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informality in the bidding or to reject any or all bids.

Each bidder must deposit with his bid, security in the amount of 5% of his bid in the form and subject to the conditions provided in the General Provisions.

Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the Contract.

Information Submitted as a matter of bidder responsiveness: The Owner's award of this contract is conditioned upon Bidder or Offeror satisfying the good faith effort requirements of 49 CFR §26.53. As a condition of bid responsiveness, the Bidder or Offeror must submit the following information with its proposal on the forms provided herein:

- 1) The names and addresses of Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) firms that will participate in the contract;
- 2) A description of the work that each DBE firm will perform;
- 3) The dollar amount of the participation of each DBE firm listed under (1)
- 4) Written statement from Bidder or Offeror that attests their commitment to use the DBE firm(s) listed under (1) to meet the Owner's project goal; and
- 5) If Bidder or Offeror cannot meet the advertised project DBE goal, evidence of good faith efforts undertaken by the Bidder or Offeror as described in appendix A to 49 CFR part 26.

The Contractor on this work will be required to comply with the equal employment opportunity requirements of the Federal Aviation Administration and the Burlington International Airport DBE Program.

No bidder may withdraw his bid prior to September 30, 2020
