The BURLINGTON INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, operated by the City of Burlington, in South Burlington, Vermont, hereby publishes a proposed overall goal for its Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program for FY 2024 – FY 2026 three-year goal of 3.12%. The proposed overall goal for FY 2024 is 2.83% for all FAA-AIP funded projects, the proposed overall goal for FY 2025 is 3.33% for all FAA-AIP funded projects, and the proposed overall goal for FY 2026 is 3.12% for all FAA-AIP funded projects. The methodology used in developing this goal is available at Burlington International Airport, 1200 Airport Drive, Suite 1, South Burlington, VT 05403, Monday through Friday, from 8 AM until 4:00 PM. The Airport/City and the FAA will receive and consider public comments on the proposed goal for 30 days from the date of this advertisement.
